Frequently Asked Questions:

Can I get information over the phone when I call?

No. For additional questions and information please email Pastor Dan at judahsgate@gmail.com.

Can I register over the phone?

No. For documentation purposes, all registrations must be handled through the website, email, or in person. Registration can be completed the first day of ClayCamp.

How do I register?

To register you would complete the online initial registration if possible and also complete the registration form. You can download the registration form from the website. You cannot register over the phone.

How long do I have to wait for someone to email me back?

Email is usually responded to the same day but will be responded to within three days. Please be patient.

What if I registered and I am not able to attend?

Please email judahsgate@gmail.com to let us know that you will not be able to make it so that the space can be opened up for someone else. The \$25 registration is a donation made out to South Evert Community Free Methodist Church and is nonrefundable.

Where is the ClayCamp?

The ClayCamp is located in the parking lot of South Evert Community Free Methodist Church, 1009 90th Ave., Evert, MI 49631. The ClayCamp is primarily an outdoor event under canopies rain or shine. There are restroom facilities and cleanup facilities provided.

Where do I check in?

The check-in table for Students is located in the South Evert Community Free Methodist Church fellowship hall.

What time should I arrive?

ClayCamp is Monday through Friday from 1:30 PM to 4:00 PM. Students should arrive between 1:15 PM and 1:25 PM to setup.

Where do I turn in my registration form?

Please bring your registration form to the event and turn it in at check in. You can also mail it to South Evert Community Free Methodist Church, 1009 90th Ave., Evert, MI 49631. If you have already made your \$25 donation and/or sent in your registration form please check in at the Students Registration table.

If I can't download a .PDF, or .DOC, how can I get the registration form?

Can I pay in advance?

Yes. And prior to the day of the ClayCamp.

Can I write a check?

Yes. Checks should be made out to South Ewart Community Free Methodist Church.

Can I attend just one or two weeks?

Yes but. ClayCamp is designed around the production of a completed piece. A completed piece in this case is a three week process. However, you would still get the instruction during the week of attendance.

What ages is ClayCamp designed for?

It is designed for all ages. Since this is a summer ClayCamp the 6 to 17 year old is the target student. By special request younger children may attend only when accompanied by a legal guardian. Parents, family members, and legal guardians are highly encouraged to stay and attend. There are no additional fees for non-student attendees. What is a non-student attendee?

Legal guardians, parents, or anyone over the age of 12 who will not be using any material or equipment. Anyone under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a legal guardian.

Can the handicap or special needs student attend?

When do we have to clean up?

The ClayCamp day runs from 1:30 PM to 4:PM and we will give a 10-20 minute warning for Students to start cleaning up. Students may not remain after 4:30 PM and their space must be cleaned prior to their departure each day of ClayCamp.

What if it rains?

ClayCamp is rain or shine! Canopies are setup to keep all high and dry and shaded. Sunscreen is always suggested.

CONSENT AGREEMENT AND RELEASE FORM

I, the undersigned parent or guardian, hereby consent to my child,
